

# Cairngorms Connect Work Placements

## Deer Management Work Placement

Learn about the importance of Deer Management for conservation. Go out stalking Deer on the hill, learn how to gralloch Deer, and help carry the carcass back to the larder where you'll be shown how to process the Deer. More generally, you will learn about ecological restoration and conservation management.

### Science and Monitoring Work Placement

Take part in ecological surveys in ecosystem restoration monitoring projects. Learn about scientific design of ecological monitoring projects and experimental trials, as well as specific monitoring methods for things like invertebrates and plants. You will gain an understanding of why science and monitoring are important for conservation.

#### Tree Nursery Work Placement

Working in the Cairngorms Connect Tree Nursery, you will learn how to grow trees from seed and cuttings. You will gain an understanding of why we grow certain species of tree, and how tree planting fits in with our wider habitat restoration work. Tasks will include weeding, watering and other types of tree maintenance.

#### Youth Engagment Work Placement

Assisting in our work with young people, helping them to learn about and engage with Cairngorms Connect's work. This could include helping with sessions with primary/secondary/post-school age-groups on school visits, field trips and creative projects. You'll also learn about documenting this work with photo and film.
